Are you a UK taxpayer?

If so, you can use Gift Aid to increase the value of your donations to CSTTT simply by completing a Gift Aid declaration. It doesn't cost you anything and increases the donation by an extra 28p* for each pound you give.

N.B. In order for us to reclaim tax you must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that CSTTT will reclaim in your donation for the tax year.

Notes:

1. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay enough income or capital gains tax to cover the amount claimed by the charity, you can cancel your declaration by notifying the charity. It will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
2. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief via your Self Assessment tax return (currently 25p for each pound you give)**
3. Please notify the charity if you change your name or address

* Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25 pence on the pound plus a Transitional Relief of 3 pence on the pound granted by HMRC until 2011.

** Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher
